## RULES

1. A fee of \$14.00 will be charged for every horse entered in the show as required by the State of California.
2. NO DRUG FEES WILL BE REFUNDED FOR ANY REASON.
3. Participation in Division 424 Showmanship is required to qualify for Hi-Point, along with competing in 4 or more classes.
4. Any animal given any type of drug within 72 hours of the show date must fill out a written declaration form for each drug administered. These forms to be completed by the exhibitor at the horse show office.
5. No refunds will be made without a vet or physician's certificate at owners expense.
6. Refunds of any kind, for any reason will be granted ONLY upon the approval of the Board of Directors of the 49th District Agricultural Association at their next regular meeting. Requests must be submitted in writing 12 days prior to that meeting.
7. Refunds will be made if a Class is canceled due to lack of entries.
8. This is a non-sanctioned show. Awards are placed at the discretion of the Judge. If you have questions regarding a class, please see the clerk for a public ruling by the judge before the class begins.
9. Driving rules will be run according to the American Driving Society, however, as a non-sanctioned show, the show is not affiliated with the Society in anyway and the ruling or placings are at the discretion of the judge.
10. The decision of the Judge is final.
11. No one under the age of 18 may handle or show a stallion on the fairgrounds.
12. Adult's Code of Conduct in this guide must have a minimum of two (2) signatures which can be from either/or:
  - a. Any parents or guardians of any child entering an animal in the Lake County Fair.
  - b. Each leader or advisor providing leadership to any child entering an animal in the Lake County Fair.
- \* This form must be completed prior to "check-in" at the fairgrounds for the competition.
12. Junior Exhibitor age 17 and under must wear properly strapped headgear while mounted or in a horse-drawn vehicle on the grounds of the Lake County Fair. Headgear must be approved by American Society for Testing and Materials/ Safety Equipment Institute (ASTM/SEI)
13. For Open Horse Show purposes the age of an exhibitor on December 1st shall be maintained through the next calendar year for Junior Mount classes only.
14. Management reserves the right to split or combine classes that are too large or too small. Any changes will be announced at least three (3) classes ahead of time.
15. Make sure you fill out your entry completely and include the entry and drug fees..
16. Mini – standing no taller than 38 inches at the withers as measured from the last hairs of the mane. Includes horses, donkeys or mules

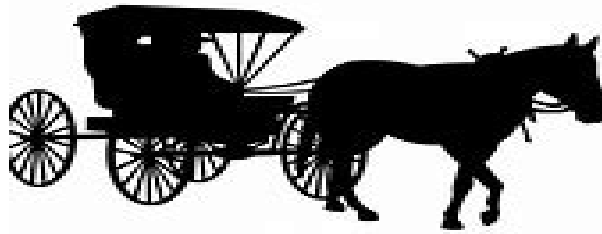
