Driving Classes: Cross-entry between Country Pleasure, Western Country Pleasure, and Carriage Driving is just fine.

Tack and driver changes will be accommodated on request.

Obstacles & In-Hand: Courses will be posted on the Area VII website and social media before the show.

The same horse may be shown by more than one exhibitor in Obstacle Driving, Halter Obstacle, and In-Hand Hunter classes. Tack and driver changes will be accommodated on request.

Dress: Neat and clean. Hats and gloves are optional, but youth exhibitors must wear helmets in driving classes.

Stallions: Can't be shown by youth exhibitors, sorry!

Please note: Anyone entering the arena must wear closed-toed shoes for safety.

Paddocks and Stalls: Must be completely stripped of all bedding and waste.

Please clean up after your horses around trailers and anywhere else on the grounds.

CARRIAGE DOG CLASS RULES



AMHR UNRATED Carriage Dog Class

The goal is to have an AMHR-rated class for 2026.

With your help and entries, we can promote this classic and elegant class.

Showcasing our carriages, turnouts, horses, and dogs.

Carriage Dog Class RULES

1. Only **one dog** per entry/vehicle is allowed.
2. The dog may be of any breed and may be a live animal or a stuffed toy. While this is **not a costume class**, if the driver accessorizes their canine, it must be done in a way that enhances the turnout.
3. The dog may ride in the vehicle either standing, sitting, or lying down. The dog can either be on the seat next to the driver or in the basket of the carriage. The dog should be quiet, well-behaved, and appear to enjoy the ride.
4. The dog may wear a leash, but the dog must **not be tied** to the driver, passenger, or vehicle. (Suggest tuck the leash under the driver, the driver should sit on the leash.)
5. If using a decorative basket, the **basket can be attached** to the vehicle, but a **dog cannot be tied to the basket**.
6. The dog will in no way interfere with the driver, nor shall the driver be distracted by the actions of the dog. The dog will not interfere with other horses, dogs, drivers, or carriages. The driver may be asked to leave the showing at any time due to any distractions of or by the driver or dog. It will be a disqualification.
7. What is expected is a well-trained companion dog that politely and calmly accompanies the turnout while riding in the vehicle.
8. 60% judged on the Suitability / Obedience of the dog, 30% on the condition, fit, and appropriateness of harness, condition of vehicle, neatness of attire, performance, and manner of horse, and 10% for the overall impression of the turnout.
9. All other AMHR Carriage Rules Apply. See Section XVI of the 2025 ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Official Rulebook, available at www.shetlandminiature.com/rulebook.
10. Don't worry, we are here to have fun. Just ask someone for help.

Most importantly, have fun and enjoy the class!

In addition, anytime you are riding your horse, or driving your horse, or leading your horse.

I understand that neither the Clay Station Horse Park or Starkey Family Trust and its officers, officials or organizing committee nor the property owners accept any responsibility for accidents, damage, injury or illness to the horses, owners, riders, drivers, grooms, passengers, attendants, spectators or any other persons or property in connection with this clinic / show / lessons. I hereby expressly agree for myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents: 1) to be bound by the rules of the Clay Station Horse Park and local rules of this clinic / show / lessons; 2) that every horse, driver, attendant, groom and/or passenger and spectator is eligible as entered; 3) and to accept as final any decision of the clinic / show officials on any question arising under the clinic / show rules and any local rules of the clinic / show and agree to hold Clay Station Horse Park and Starkey Family Trust harmless from and against all claims including any injury or loss suffered during or in conjunction with the clinic / show or facility whether or not such claim, injury or loss resulted, either directly or indirectly, from negligent acts or omissions of the Clay Station Horse Park or Starkey Family Trust.
