General Rules and Information

This is an ASPC/AMHR sanctioned show, open to any ASPC/AMHR registered horse or pony whose exhibitor is able to show proof of valid registration.

Additionally, we are offering “VSE” non-rated classes for all horses and ponies 48” and under. These classes are marked (NR) in the class list.

Horses will be judged and classes will be run in accordance with ASPC/AMHR rules. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the rules and regulations as well as the requirement of each class entered. A copy of the Official Rulebook will be available in the show office. It is also available for download (PDF) at www.shetlandminiature.com.

Exhibitors must provide a copy of valid registration papers for each horse entered, and a copy of their Amateur Card (if applicable) with their entry form. Amateur Cards may be purchased at the show from the Show Steward.

Show Office

The show office will open no later than 2:00 p.m. on Friday, April 24, and at least one hour prior to show start on each show day.

Measuring

All horses shall be measured in accordance with ASPC/AMHR rules. If your horse has a current year measurement card or has been measured within the last 60 days, please submit a copy of your card with your entry. All horses will be measured by the Show Steward with an official certified ASPC/AMHR measuring stick at the times listed below. Any other time will be at the convenience of the Show Steward upon request, but not to interfere with his/her show responsibilities.

Registration papers and other necessary paperwork *must* be presented to the Show Steward for each animal entered at the time of measurement. To expedite measuring, please come to the measuring area with the horses free of blankets, sheets, hoods, sleezies, etc., and make sure you have your paperwork filled out in advance.

Measuring Times

- Friday, April 24: 4:00 p.m.–7:00 p.m.
- Saturday, April 25: 7:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m.
- Sunday, April 26: 7:00 a.m. to 7:45 a.m.

Awards

This show has two judges. Points and awards will be given by each judge.

- Championship ribbons will be awarded for Junior/Senior Champions and Grand Champions.
- Championship ribbons will be awarded to first and second place winners in the driving stakes classes.

Barbara Naviaux Memorial Multi-Color Champion

Class 212. The champion will be chosen from the first place winners from the AMHR Multi-Color classes—classes 70, 116, 193, and 210.

High Point Awards

High Point Awards will be presented to:

Youth: Ages 7 & Under, 8–12, 13–17

Amateur, VSE, and Open.

Exhibitors must sign up in advance to be eligible for these awards. See pages 6–7 for the rules and the sign-up form.

Carriage Driving High Point

All entrants in all Carriage Driving classes will be eligible for the Carriage Driving High Point.

Entry Procedures

- **Entries close Monday, April 10.** Entries postmarked after April 10 will be charged a post-entry fee of \$30/horse.
- Entries must be on the official entry form for this show. Entry forms may be photocopied for use.
- All requested information must be provided for each horse entered. Forms will not be accepted unless they are complete and accompanied by required fees and a copy of the AMHR or ASPC registration papers for the horse on the entry form. All entries must include the complete name and registration number of the horse exactly as it is shown on the registration papers.

- No numbers will be released without full payment of all fees.
- No entries will be accepted over the phone.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the accuracy of the entry forms prepared by themselves or their agents.
- There will be a \$50 charge for all checks returned due to lack of funds. This must be paid before entry numbers will be issued.

Amateur Exhibitors

Must have an official Amateur Card to show in amateur classes. If a photocopy of your Amateur Card is not provided when you mail your entry, bring your Amateur Card to the show office when you pick up your packet. Amateur Cards may also be purchased from the Show Steward with proof of current ASPC/AMHR membership.

Youth Exhibitors

This show is participating in the ASPC/AMHR Youth High Point program. To be eligible for the Shetland and/or Miniature Youth High Point award, ASPC/AMHR youth membership is required. Youth membership is free. Membership forms are available online at www.shetlandminiature.com, and will also be available at the show.

Gelding Status

Must be shown on registration forms.

Foals of Current Year

Foals of the current year must be registered prior to the show.

Out of State Horses

Coggins test (current within 1 year), and health certificate within 30 days must be provided. Foals 6 months and younger do not require Coggins.

Post-Entries/Adding Classes

- After the closing date for entries, **April 10**, a flat post-entry fee of \$30 per horse.
- Additional classes for horses entered by April 10 may be added without a post-entry penalty.

- Post-entries for added classes will be accepted up to five classes prior to the class entering the ring, provided that the horse is determined to be eligible for entry.
- Post-entries made for the first five classes of the day will be accepted up to one-half hour prior to the first class entering the ring.
- Post-entries made during the show must be made at the show office. Management reserves the right to accept entries for unfilled classes.

Scratched Classes—Refunds

- No entry fees will be refunded without a veterinarian's certificate as to the unsoundness of the entered horse. This must be presented to the show manager before the first class of the day. Failure to show a horse that has been entered constitutes a forfeiture of entry fees.
- In the event of the sudden illness of a horse after the entry deadline, exhibitor may substitute another animal at no additional charge. If done at the show, it must be done with the timeframe outlined in the post-entry details. Refunds will be sent to exhibitors after the conclusion of the show.

Scheduling, Gate Holds, Etc.

If you need a gate hold for an equipment change, please notify the show office at least five classes in advance. We'll do our best to accommodate you, but we have a full class schedule and need to limit gate holds to three minutes if possible. Breaks will be announced.

Hi Point Awards for California Classic

We will be presenting awards to the following Hi Point Categories:

Amateur

Open

VSE

Youth (3 age groups)

Rules: You MUST sign up before the start of the show to be eligible for these awards. There is no cost to sign up.

In the **Open Division** points will follow the horse and can be shown by multiple handlers.

The **Amateur, Youth & VSE Divisions** points follow the Horse & Handler Team. You may show multiple horses, but the points follow that Horse & Handler Team, not the exhibitor.

There is no limit to how many horses or "teams" you sign up. You may also compete in multiple divisions, such as Open and Amateur or Amateur and VSE, etc.

Points will be tabulated according to the class size. Example below:

6+ in a class: 1st - 6pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt.

5 in a class: 1st - 5pts, 2nd - 4pts, etc.

4 in a class: 1st - 4pts, etc.

You are limited to using only ONE of your Driving Classes and ONE Halter class, but you are not "required" to use a Halter or Driving class. Carriage Driving and Roadster count as a Driving Class. The Classes entered must be in your division, such as having Amateur, Youth or VSE in the class name. The rest are considered Open classes.

You may enter as many of the following classes in your division as you wish:

Halter Obstacle, Driving Obstacle, Hunter, Jumper, Showmanship, Liberty.

Note: VSE Carriage Dog and VSE Carriage Reinsmanship may be used for the Youth, Open, and Amateur Division for extra points as well

You must enter all the class names and class numbers you want tracked for points on your sign up form.

CARRIAGE DOG CLASS RULES



AMHR UNRATED Carriage Dog Class

The goal is to have an AMHR-rated class for 2026.

With your help and entries, we can promote this classic and elegant class.

Showcasing our carriages, turnouts, horses, and dogs.

Carriage Dog Class RULES

1. Only **one dog** per entry/vehicle is allowed.
2. The dog may be of any breed and may be a live animal or a stuffed toy. While this is **not a costume class**, if the driver accessorizes their canine, it must be done in a way that enhances the turnout.
3. The dog may ride in the vehicle either standing, sitting, or lying down. The dog can either be on the seat next to the driver or in the basket of the carriage. The dog should be quiet, well-behaved, and appear to enjoy the ride.
4. The dog may wear a leash, but the dog must **not be tied** to the driver, passenger, or vehicle. (Suggest tuck the leash under the driver, the driver should sit on the leash.)
5. If using a decorative basket, the **basket can be attached** to the vehicle, but a **dog cannot be tied to the basket**.
6. The dog will in no way interfere with the driver, nor shall the driver be distracted by the actions of the dog. The dog will not interfere with other horses, dogs, drivers, or carriages. The driver may be asked to leave the showing at any time due to any distractions of or by the driver or dog. It will be a disqualification.
7. What is expected is a well-trained companion dog that politely and calmly accompanies the turnout while riding in the vehicle.
8. 60% judged on the Suitability / Obedience of the dog, 30% on the condition, fit, and appropriateness of harness, condition of vehicle, neatness of attire, performance, and manner of horse, and 10% for the overall impression of the turnout.
9. All other AMHR Carriage Rules Apply. See Section XVI of the 2025 ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Official Rulebook, available at www.shetlandminiature.com/rulebook.
10. Don't worry, we are here to have fun. Just ask someone for help.

1. Water is metered, please use this precious resource wisely
2. Horses must only be washed in wash racks
3. When stabling at MEC, please bring a water bucket and hose. Please do not empty your water buckets in the stall at the end of the show
4. It is your responsibility to check your stall(s)/area and sanitize. Any concerns or problems, please call MEC management
5. Do not put any nails or screws in the walls (including nails for curtains)
6. Do not tie horses or hang items from barn cables
7. All garbage and manure must be placed in appropriate disposal areas
8. Dogs must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in the food service areas, concessions, or bleachers. Proof of rabies vaccination for all Dogs brought to the Facility is required
9. Dog(s) in the show office/show staff dogs must be secured with a leash, pen, or contained in an office. It is preferred not to have multiple dogs in the show office.
10. No leading horses or dogs from golf carts or other vehicles
11. All participants are responsible to sign a liability release with show management
12. Parking is permitted ONLY in designated areas only (please be aware of fire and emergency access). ALL HORSE TRAILERS & RV's must be parked in designated parking areas. There will be no trailers permitted in the barn isles, including the side and front of the barns; show management is responsible for enforcing and reinforcing this rule throughout the show, advertisements and flyer postings are ONLY allowed on the designated "posting boards" located by each arena

I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any equestrian event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases such as COVID-19), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of MEC or Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers.
