I understand that neither the Clay Station Horse Park or Starkey Family Trust and its officers, officials or organizing committee nor the property owners accept any responsibility for accidents, damage, injury or illness to the horses, owners, riders, drivers, grooms, passengers, attendants, spectators or any other persons or property in connection with this clinic/show/lessons.
